

Sunday Grade Family Mass

Student Volunteer Roles

GREETER

- Before Mass, greeters should be assigned to 3 areas: the Hall of Saints entrance (inside or out), the vestibule and church steps—pending weather
- Invite them to offer up a smile to everyone and a “welcome”, “good morning” or “hello”.
- At 10:00 when the Mass starts, they can be seated.
 - We don't have a limit on greeters.

PRESCHOOL AND SOR FAMILY ENTRANCE PROCESSION: GOSPEL GIFT AND BANNER SIGN

- Families line up in the vestibule for entrance procession (Cue up last in line: Preschool family with gift first, followed by SOR family and banner)
- When the priest is ready, he will start the procession
- Preschool family should place their gift on the center steps of the altar, bow, and return to seat
- SOR family should place their banner in front of the ambo (lectern on left), bow, and return to seat
- Limit of 2 families: 1 for Gospel Gift/ 1 for Banner

PRAYERS OF THE FAITHFUL

- The petition reader will arrive with their petitions in hand. And hopefully, they will have practiced it.
- Direct the petition reader to sit in the front side pews to the left of the altar when they arrive.
- About 30 minutes into the Mass after the Creed (“We believe in one God”), the adult reader will tap the student on the shoulder when it's their turn to read.
- The adult and student readers will head up to ambo
- The student reader will then wait for the adult reader to finish before they both walk back to their seat.
 - Limit of 1 reader.

BULLETIN GIVER INSTRUCTIONS

- After communion, bulletin givers should head to the Vestibule to pick up a stack of bulletins (located on table or wall holder) and head to their assigned area: the Hall of Saints entrance (inside or out), the Vestibule, and Church Steps—pending weather
- Once they're in their post, remind them to offer up a smile to all, along with a bulletin to one adult in the family. If people do not want a bulletin, it's fine.
 - Wish all to “Have a Nice Day”
- Once the crowd has thinned (15 minutes), they are free to leave
 - We don't have a limit on ushers.
