

Sounds of Christmas 2019 Dancer Information

Dancer Commitment:

As a participant in the Sounds of Christmas production, you must be available and committed to attend all practices, rehearsals and performance dates below. This includes Sunday afternoon practices for your assigned number(s), each night of tech week rehearsals and four SOC productions. Dancers who must miss two or more practices/rehearsals will lose their spots. **You must be available to participate in ALL FOUR productions - there are no exceptions.**

Financial Commitment:

Mount Paran Worship will provide all costumes for dancers. If dancers already own shoes specific to their number, we ask that you use them; otherwise, Mount Paran will provide those. All costumes/shoes must be turned in after the final performance. Dancers will be responsible for providing their own makeup, hair products (i.e. bobby pins, hair spray) and appropriate undergarments (i.e. tights, sports bra).

Sounds of Christmas dance practices will be held on **Sunday afternoons between 1:30-4:00pm**. Each dance number will be given a time slot between 30 minutes and 1-hour.
