

# FAB AT FRAZE

Fairmont Athletic Boosters volunteer for the Beer, Wine and Ice Cream tents. Depending on the event, we don't always have the same tents or responsibilities.

## General Rules:

- All volunteers will wear appropriate clothing – navy or khaki shorts, skorts, or pants – a shirt that is either a 'team' shirt or non-descript - **closed toe shoes** are a must.
- All volunteers who will be working must be 21 years of age or older. While we usually work ice cream, this is not always the case so no one under 21 years of age. **No exceptions!**
- Please park in one of the out-lots – KFHS lots are preferable.
- No purses please – there is really no safe place to keep them in the tents. If you must bring a cell phone, please set it to vibrate and leave it in your pocket.
- Absolutely NO SMOKING in or around any of the Booster tents. If you cannot wait until your shift is over to smoke – please wait until there is some 'down time' in your tent and then proceed to a designated smoking area.
- If a break is needed to eat – please wait for 'down time' and do not eat inside a Booster tent.
- Upon check-in prior to every event – each Booster tent will be assigned a Frazee employee contact that will provide replacement product. Please do not get product on your own – it will only confuse the inventory and might make your team earn less \$ if not recorded properly.
- Frazee personnel will commandeer 'changing of the guard' when we have two or more groups assigned to a Festival. The first group will meet at the wall at the end of Ernie's concession stand – the second group should gather just past that wall at the very end of the concession building – where the concrete wall integrates with the metal fencing.
- Note that all volunteers are required to leave the park as soon as they are dismissed. The exceptions are the "free" events such as festivals, etc. The only exception is if the volunteer has a ticket for the event.

## Alcohol Service:

- All patrons requesting to purchase alcoholic beverages **must** be wearing a colored wristband – Wristband color is decided on the night of the event. Boosters will be given the wristband color information at the pre-event/mid-event meeting. **NO WRISTBAND – NO DRINK!**
- Service will be limited to **two alcoholic beverages per person** – (one per hand) – absolutely **NO EXCEPTIONS**—should a violation of this rule be observed, the Booster group tent **will** be shut down and no proceeds from that booth will be attributed to our Booster program.
- **Absolutely no consumption of alcohol will be tolerated during our tenure as Booster volunteers.** If the event is a 'free' show – then the volunteer is welcome to go to the entrance and obtain a wristband – purchase alcoholic beverages and enjoy the venue once their shift is over.
- Booster volunteers will be given two 'money aprons' for their assigned post – (only one in the case of ice cream) – at intervals during any event - Frazee personnel will come by and collect big bills and be able to give smaller bills should they be needed.
- Beer and wine **will be sufficiently replenished by Frazee personnel** during the course of the event.
- Beer bottle caps and wine cups need to be counted and recorded as per the instructions given by the Frazee personnel at each event.
- Booster volunteers are not permitted to accept tips.

## Ice Cream:

- The ice cream tent will be restocked as needed for each event.
