Volunteer Job Assignment: Beer Garden Perimeter

Time: 5:30 pm – 9:30 pm

Information for all volunteers:

- Please remember that this is a major fundraising event for the Starkey Foundation and you are representing Starkey
- Smile and thank participants whenever the opportunity arises
- **STARKEY NO ALCOHOL POLICY IS IN EFFECT FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS AND STAFF DURING THE EVENT**
- What to wear:
 - Starkey tan volunteer polo
 - Dark pants/capris or nice jeans (no holes/frayed areas)
 - Comfortable shoes.
- If you need assistance at any time please contact:

- CHECK IN AT VOLUNTEER CHECK IN FIRST.
- Volunteer check in is at the parking lot on the northwest corner of Texas and Oak, part of the Credit Union of America. Volunteer check-in is separate from participant check-in.

Duties:

5:30

- After checking in at the Credit Union, proceed to Beer Garden across the street from Aero Plains.
- Gather supplies - One of the staff at your location will have your supplies (Sharpie, bucket, pitcher)
- Ask the store staff where you can fill your pitcher with water (about ½ full for rinsing taster cups), or use bottled water if needed.
- Take your bucket and pitcher with you to the entrance of the Beer Garden

6:00 to 9:00

- Greet attendees with a smile and thank them for coming and supporting Starkey. Remember you are their first impression, please make it a positive and friendly one.
- Put an 'X' over the store initial (BG) on their wristband as they enter to indicate they have received their samples & food at your location.
- **DO NOT LET ANYONE IN WITHOUT A WRISTBAND!** If they do not have a wristband, they may not enter the location. The guest should have received their wristband, and taster when they checked in. If they have a ticket and do not have a wristband & taster, please direct them to the check-in area where indicated on their ticket (there are 3 check-in areas).

- **If they do not have a wristband, they MUST wait outside so we stay within compliance of the law**
- When the attendee is ready to leave, be sure to dump any remaining beer from their sample glass into the bucket before they leave the location. They may NOT take their beer or wine with them. **DO NOT LET ANYONE LEAVE THE LOCATION WITH ALCOHOL IN THEIR TASTER CUP!**
- You may rinse out the taster cup with a small amount of water from your pitcher (not from the bucket).
- If bucket starts to get too full or you need more water for your pitcher, check with store staff on where to dump the contents
- Beer and wine is NOT available for volunteers and/or Starkey staff.
- If anyone has an issue with not being served a sample for whatever reason (over indulged, already had a sample at your location, etc.), please contact Volunteer Support or Eileen at 253-7607. Security officers will be on site.
- If a participant should drop and break their mug, please clean up broken glass as quickly as possible with provided dustpan/broom and give participant replacement taster. If out, call Volunteer Support for more.
- Please help to keep your area clean of spills and trash

9:00

- Last call is at 9:00.
- Please be patient if attendees linger. It means they are having a good time!
- When the last attendee has left the location, assist in cleaning up any trash, paper, etc.
- Rinse out bucket.
- Take clear plastic liner out of trash box and tie at top
- Breakdown the trash box.
- Put supplies back in clean bucket for easier transport
- Take trash, trash box, supplies, Starkey tables, and any leftover beer to Bell Carpet parking lot
- Make sure all leftover alcohol is taken to the loading truck
- Your volunteer assignment is not complete until the area is fully broken down and everything is loaded on to trucks.
- You will then collect your volunteer thank you gift.
