Health Screening Questionnaire:

We are required as part of the re-opening requirements to ask each person registering to complete the following self-assessment.

If your response to any of the following questions is "yes," we regret that you must refrain from attending Mass until time has passed such that your responses are all "no."

In the last 14 days, have you:

- 1. Traveled internationally?
- 2. Been exposed to a person with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 without the correct PPE?
- 3. Had a temperature at least 100.4°F?
- 4. Had new or increased shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
- 5. Had a new cough?
- 6. Had at least two of the following symptoms together:
 - Chills
 - Muscle pain
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - New loss of taste or smell

- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Runny nose / congestion
- Fatigue

Thank you for your understanding in the process of compliance with Washington State guidelines. Our compliance allows for the public celebration of Mass to be possible. As we have more parishioners who wish to attend Mass than slots per weekend, your honesty is a gracious opportunity for another person to attend.
