COVID-19 Drive-Up Vaccination Information

- **Don't come if you are sick:** Please do not come to your appointment if you are sick or have symptoms that could be COVID-19.
- We can't vaccinate you at the drive-up site if:
 - You have ever experienced an allergic reaction or anaphylaxis to an injectable medicine or vaccine, including the first dose of Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine.
 - You have ever had a severe allergic reaction (e.g., anaphylaxis) to something other than a vaccine or injectable medication; such as food, pets, venom, or oral medication
 - You are coming for your second dose of vaccine and <u>do not bring</u> your vaccine card
 - You are not at least 18 years of age
- We can vaccinate a maximum of 4 people per vehicle: You will be staying in the car for the entire process and need to be in a window seat. If you have a preference for which arm receives the shot, make sure you are seated on the correct side of the car. Left shoulder = driver's side. Right shoulder = passenger side.
- What to wear: Wear something that makes it easy to expose an upper arm for your shot.
- When to arrive: Please don't come early; early arrivals can create long lines for everyone.
- **Observation:** After your shot, you will be asked to wait in an observation area for either 15 or 30 minutes to make sure you don't have an adverse reaction.
- Why aren't all vaccine providers wearing gloves? Gloves are not required for vaccinating, and medical gloves are in short supply. Regulators and medical experts agree that proper hand hygiene is an appropriate option instead.

• Location: Sunrise Center at 18901 E Burnside St., Portland, 97233. Driveway is only accessible when driving eastbound on Burnside. Turn right into first driveway.
