Air Quality Warnings

California is prone to wildfires. When fires occur, air quality decreases and can produce a significant amount of smoke held in the upper atmosphere and can reach ground level throughout the state. Local air quality conditions can deteriorate quickly.

Levels of smoke and particles, and areas impacted, will vary. When you see or smell smoke in the air, be cautious and use common sense to protect your and your family's health. Everyone, especially people with heart or lung disease (including asthma), older adults, pregnant women, and children, should limit time spent outdoors and avoid outdoor exercise when high concentrations of smoke and particles are in the air.

For that reason, if air quality conditions deteriorate to hazardous levels, it may become necessary for the Aquatic Section to shut down or cancel programming. In the event that your lap swim reservation is cancelled, all possible efforts will be made to reschedule your reservation for the same time slot on the corresponding day for the following week.
