Volunteer Job Assignment: Hole in One/Closest to the Pin

Time: 12 pm – 6 pm Location: Hole #17

Duties:

- Please check before 12 pm and be ready at your assignment before the first golfers that tee's off at 8 arrive (estimated between 12:20-12:50). Lunch is available at the clubhouse before you go to your hole.
- Please bring a chair with you to sit in at your hole! A chair will NOT be provided for you. Volunteers from Davis-Moore will also be at this hole.
- You will have one cart assigned to you and your partner. Please go together to your hole assignment.
- Please be prepared to set up your 10 x 10 pop up shelter.
- Volunteers will be located on the tee box and one on the green as an observer. Observer on green may get name in paper as observer to a winner! Davis-Moore will also have volunteers at this hole.
- As golfers approach the tee box, greet with a smile, and explain this is a prize hole.
- Rules of Play:
 - HOLE IN ONE AND CLOSEST TO THE PIN ARE PAY TO PLAY GAMES
 - Golfer may have paid at registration. If so, they will have a blue Starkey wristband.
 - They have only one chance.
 - If the golfer's tee shot hits the ball and it goes in the hole on their first swing, it is a HOLE IN ONE and they win!
 - Prize is a car from Davis-Moore!
 - If tee shot is closest to the pin (the flag in the hole) use marker to indicate where ball came to rest.
 - Note on form golfers name and team. Golfer's generally know how to use the club marker and will do themselves.
 - Move marker and document when someone else hits a closer shot: use the tape measure as a measuring rod.
 - The winner(s) will be announced after the tournament.
- You will have one cart assigned to you and your partner. Please go together to your hole assignment.
- Monitor hole from the green for hole in one activity.
- If someone makes a hole in one. Take the names of everyone who observed the shot volunteers, golfers, others who may have been around.
- Congratulate the winner! Notify Eileen @253-7607 of all HIO winners shortly after win.
- Please notify Volunteer Support Brenda McKenney @ 706-0217 or Eileen @ 253-7607 if you need a break for the restroom, etc. Restrooms are located in the Clubhouse, between holes #6 & #7, and between holes #13 & #14.
- Please do not leave your station unattended! Please make sure that there is at least two people monitoring game play this can include someone from Davis-Moore.
- When the last team has come through, take tent down and collapse table (if applicable), collect signage, and pack remaining supplies in container (if any) to be returned to the Clubhouse. Please return these items to the front of the clubhouse.

- Assist in truck loading at conclusion of event.
- When you finish your assignment, please check out with Volunteer Support, document the time you left, and drop off your name badge. Thank you!
- Other duties as assigned.
