

Sunday School Rotation Leader Volunteer Job Description

Position Description: Teach children in Sunday School for a 3 week rotation

Time Frame: 3 Sundays at a time, September – May, 9:15 – 10:15 am.

Duties:

9:15 – 9:30

- Arrive between 9:00 and 9:10 on Sunday mornings and begin in the Sanctuary.
- Sit with your class in the Sanctuary for the opening time together.
- Participate with them during the opening worship time upstairs.
- If you are teaching the 5th & 6th graders, you will begin downstairs in the Brown Room for the service project.

9:30-9:45

- You will be dismissed by class to go to the Social Hall for snacks.
- Snacks are provided in the upstairs kitchen by whomever is serving coffee that week at church.
- Please sit with your class during their snack time.

9:45-10:15

- Class time using Spark Curriculum.
- Lisa will prepare the lesson for you each week, including all materials.
- Materials will be in your classroom as needed.
- Additional materials are available in the Supply Closet located at the back of the downstairs kitchen.
- The curriculum is a guideline – feel free to create, change, and ad lib as you see fit!
- At 10:15, you may dismiss your group to head upstairs. If you finish your lesson before 10:15, please keep them in the classroom until 10:15. You may play some tried and true games such as “Heads Up, 7 Up”, “charades” or “Hangman” to fill the time!

Other:

- Lisa will share with you the specific grade rotation and room location based on your station.
- You will be made aware of any special needs or allergies.
- Any materials or supplies you decide to purchase will be reimbursed. Submit your receipt to Lisa, or to Sherry Swanson or Linda Place (church treasurers).
