KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



As the past president and CEO of Mental Health Colorado, Andrew Romanoff led the fight for the prevention and treatment of mental health and substance use disorders. Among the results: pathbreaking programs for children and families and \$68 million per year in life-saving services for Coloradans in need. Romanoff won four terms in the Colorado House of Representatives—including two terms as speaker of the House. During that time, he earned recognition from more than 50 state and national organizations as one of the most effective legislative leaders in America.

Romanoff has spent decades working in various roles such as battling the Ku Klux Klan and Neo-Nazi groups at the Southern Poverty Law Center, as one of the founders of the Posner Center for International Development in Denver and teaching English in rural Nicaragua. Andrew earned a bachelor's degree at Yale, a master's degree in public policy at Harvard, and a juris doctorate at the University of Denver.



Patrice N. Douglas is a Licensed Therapist, Certified Anger Management Specialist, and Certified Parent Child Interaction Therapist in California and Texas as well as the owner of Empire Counseling & Consultation located in CA, NY, & TX. She is currently a doctoral candidate at The Chicago School of Professional Psychology in Los Angeles studying clinical psychology. She specializes in anger management, men's issues, and minority mental health. Patrice is passionate about decreasing stigmas in minority communities by curating initiatives and has been featured in Bustle, HelloGiggles, BuzzFeed,

Therapy For Black Girls, *Oprah Magazine*, and other platforms discussing the various topics surrounding mental health.
