

Family Promise WELCOME KITS

1. Family Promise Coordinators identify which Welcome Kit(s) they would like to provide
 - a. Provide 4 kits. Church(es)/organizations could figure out the best way to do it, whether it was to put together several kits and have them on hand or do to it when a family gets housing
2. Place the items in a CLEAR plastic tub that can close (except oversized items such as brooms, trash cans, and diapers, indicated by an asterisk below).
3. Please purchase NEW items unless indicated. If donating used items, please make sure they are only GENTLY used.
4. We also encourage you to include a hand-written, unsealed note welcoming the family.
5. Drop off the Kit at designated location when family moves in .
