Radio Etiquette/Care:

Radios will be checked In/out by Digital. Each volunteer needs a Radio. When your shift is over you will Exchange Radio with Incoming Shadow.

Do not let Participants use your Radio. Never leave your radio Unattended. Never Announce over Radio that LEO is at Gate or Entering Property.

<u>Do not take Radio's into the Port o Potties.</u> You will have to Retreive them and be Responsible for it if you Drop it into the Wild Bluish Yonder!

How do we use the Radio's you Say? They are pretty simple actaully but we need to speak in our own Burner Talk, as long as you're appropriate and aren't blocking up the channel most things are OK. Do not use Profanity or actaul names since LEO (Law Enforcement Officer), or Anyone with a Scanner can listen to Us. let's not make a Bad Impression of us or Give Out Personal Information! If Unsure if can be said on the Radio ask Digital for a Face to Face.

When using the Radio hold the Button down the whole time you are Talking and let it Go when you are done. Wait a Second after you hold the Button before you Start Talking. Know what you want to say before you Talk and keep it Simple and to the Point.

When calling for Someone you must call their Burner Name or Position Twice then You're Burner Name or Position Once. Remember this to Help (Who Who You). Wait for Response, If no Response Try again. Look to see if you are on the right Channel and Volume. Channels will be Set at Event and a Laminate Card at you're Post will have all this Information for you! "Practice Using Radio's"

All Comm, All Comm Means Stop and Listen. Announcements or Info is being Broadcasted.

Break Break Break Means End all Radio Chatter Immediatly, Incident or Emergency. Be Prepared to write down Any Descriptions or Instructions!

Disoriented Is the only word we use on the Radio to Describe an Out of Sorts Participant!
