Through these productions, we seek to enlarge and build our community, honour and celebrate the gifts of God through the performing arts, while providing quality entertainment for our friends and neighbours.

Thanks for your interest in HUC's 2020 production of *Matilda the Musical*! Please <u>review this information</u> <u>carefully</u> so you are aware of how to prepare for your audition, and what to expect for rehearsals and the production.

Commitment Dates

Musical theatre is a highly rewarding experience, and a great deal of fun. Successful productions require enormous effort and coordination of a large team, with maximum commitment from everyone.

By signing up to audition, <u>you are making a commitment</u> to the rest of the cast and crew to give <u>your</u> maximum effort to the show. While limited absences may be accommodated during rehearsals, <u>YOU <u>MUST</u> BE ABLE TO ATTEND <u>ALL</u> TECH REHEARSALS AND SHOW PERFORMANCES (April 26 – May 3).</u>

- Wednesday evening rehearsals will be for main characters only.
- When there are rehearsals you cannot attend, advise us as soon as possible (see Contact Info below).
- If you already know of absences, CIRCLE THESE DATES on the back of the Audition Form, and be prepared to discuss them during your audition.
- As the show develops, EXPECT additional rehearsals to be scheduled. Updated schedules will be announced at rehearsals, and by communication from the stage manager.

Special notes regarding young children:

We value the participation of ALL ages, and we care about the safety of your children. Rehearsals are not structured to provide childcare or supervision. Therefore, parents of young children are expected to attend rehearsals with their child(ren).

Auditions

Auditions help us find the best way to use the abundant talents of our community in the cast and crew. Each person auditioning for a stage role should

- Complete the attached Audition Information Sheet and <u>bring it with you</u> to the audition. (Children MUST bring this form signed by a parent or legal guardian.)
- Complete a Photo and Video Release form, also attached. These MUST also be signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- For your audition, prepare according to your interest:
 - o Everyone: A song from <u>musical theatre</u> (about 1-2 minutes duration)
 - o Main or Supporting characters: prepare one of the monologues found below.
- No accompanist will be provided. A speaker will be available with a standard 3.5 mm aux input, for connection to an iPod, phone or other music player.
- **BE ON TIME** for your audition slot. If your circumstances change and you cannot attend your time slot, please advise us (contact info below).

We value everyone's participation, and the limitations of our facility and high interest in our shows mean that we may not be able to find stage roles for everyone. Those that are not cast onstage will be offered opportunities to participate backstage, building and painting sets, concession and front of house.

Official casting notices will be sent shortly following auditions.

Costumes & Clothing

In addition to the costumes created for the production by our amazing Costume team, you may be asked to provide (or purchase, if necessary) specific clothing items to fit a theme (tops/shirts, pants, tights, socks, shoes). These requirements will be provided to you *at least* one month prior to the show.

Ticket Sales

Part of your commitment is to help sell tickets. We are a volunteer-run production, but considerable costs are incurred in staging the show. We receive very limited commercial sponsorship support, and HUC does not accept lottery-funded provincial grants, so almost all our costs are covered by YOUR ticket sales. You will also be asked to take turns selling tickets before and after Sunday services at HUC in March and April. Please be prepared to take your turn!

Suggested Audition Monologues (Main and Supporting Cast Roles)

Matilda

Once upon a time the two greatest circus performers in the world – an escapologist, who could escape from any lock that was ever invented, and an acrobat, who was so skilled it seemed as if she could actually fly – fell in love and got married. They performed some of the most incredible feats together anyone has ever seen and people would come from miles around: Kings, Queens, Celebrities and Astronauts. And not just to see their skill, but also to see their love for each other, which was so deep that it was said that cats would purr as they passed them and dogs would weep with joy.

Mr Wormwood

I would like to offer an apology for some of the things that have been going on here tonight. They are not nice things and they are not right things and I would like to state garrantorically that we do not want any children that might be here tonight watching this to go home and try these things out for themselves. I am of course talking about reading books.

Miss Trunchbull:

...miserable collection of excuses for children, and you, madam, standing there like the squit of squits, are its beating heart. But I am a match for you and I tell you that there is nothing that I shall not do, no length to which I shall not go, no punishment I shall not inflict, no ear I shall not stretch back, no finger I shall not what is it?...what is it? ...Get it off me. Get it off me...it's heading north...

Miss Honey:

you're going to need help. I'm Lavender. And I think it's probably for the best if we're best friends.

Bruce:

Okay, look, alright, I stole the cake. And honestly I was really, definitely, sort of almost thinking about owning up...maybe? But the thing was I was having a lot of trouble with my belly. You see, the Trunchbull's cake was so good that I'd scoffed it down too quick and now it was beginning to fight back. (*His belly rumbles*.) Ooops. See?

Mrs Wormwood:

Escapologist he says! What about me then? I've got a whole house to look after – dinners don't microwave themselves you know! If you're an escapologist I must be an acrobat to balance that lot – the world's greatest acrobat. I am off to bleach my roots and I shan't be talking to you for the rest of the evening, you . . .horrid little man!


