

## **RED KETTLE VOLUNTEER INSTRUCTIONS**

1. **If you are the first bell ringer of the day,** pick up the kettle stand, kettle, Salvation Army metal sign (and volunteer sign if there is one for your group), and bell ringer supply bag at the customer service desk.



- 2. Set up the kettle stand, sign(s), and kettle outside in the designated area.
- 3. Retrieve the bells, aprons and paint stick from the bell ringer supply bag.
- 4. Wear the apron. Ring the bell and greet shoppers.
- 5. If you need to leave before a replacement arrives, return the kettle to a customer service desk representative.
- 6. If you are relieving the current bell ringer, simply take over for them.
- 7. If you are the last bell ringer of the day, return all supplies, signs and kettle to a customer service clerk at the service desk.

## PLEASE NOTE:

- ✓ <u>Do not leave the kettle unattended at any time.</u>
- ✓ Use the paint stick to push money into the kettle.
- $\checkmark$  Do not leave personal items visible around the kettle.
- ✓ Please do not use tobacco products while volunteering.
