Procedures Foxfield Pool

The following additional pool facility procedures are in place for the safety of all members and staff.

- Members of the Foxfield Community and individuals with outside paid memberships ("Members") who are in good standing and have a valid 2020 Pool Pass may enter the pool. There are <u>no guests</u> permitted.
- Members may schedule pool time using the online system after signing the Pool User Agreement, https://www.signupgenius.com/go/20F0D4FABA622A6FF2-foxfield2. In person requests will need to sign a hard copy the Pool User Acknowledgement at the Pool. Members may also call the pool and speak to a lifeguard to schedule a reservation at 703-378-9880, please note that guards will not be able to pick up the phone if they are busy.
- All members under the age of 15 must be accompanied by a family member 16 years of age or older.
- Members who are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 may not enter the pool.
- Members agree to follow all instructions on the signage posted in and around the pool facility.
- Members are encouraged to shower and use the bathroom at their homes prior to coming to the pool.
- Currently, each household may sign up for a 2-hour block, no more than 1 block per day, and no more than 5 days a week. This will be amended if needed. The quarter to the hour break will not be called during this time period.
- Sign-ups will open up every Sunday at 9 AM for the following week.
- Currently, 40 members are permitted per 2-hour block.
- Members must show their 2020 Pool pass, sign in to the login book upon entry to the pool facility, and complete a hard copy of the Pool User Acknowledgement or bring a completed copy with you to give to the guards each time you come in to the facility. Please bring a pen or pencil with you to limit contact.
- If you show up to the pool without a reservation in the sign-up system and there are no available unreserved blocks, you may be turned away.
- Members may bring their own chairs. No Foxfield pool furniture will be available for use. Umbrellas have been placed to provide shade and may only be opened and closed by guards. Umbrellas may not be moved.

- Members must keep 10 feet apart from other individuals outside of their household who are also using the pool.
- Face coverings on the pool deck and in the restrooms are highly encouraged.
- All staff will wear face coverings when not in the lifeguard chair.
- To limit contact surfaces, there are <u>no rafts</u>, <u>water guns</u>, <u>or toys permitted</u>. Flotation devices such as floaties, life vests, or puddle jumpers are permitted to assist in swimming.
- Members will immediately exit the facility at the end of their time block. There will be no bathroom use permitted following your scheduled time block as the guards will need that time to clean the facility for the next group coming in. This means no bathroom or shower use following your pool time.
- Procedures may be modified by the Board Pool Committee with permission from the Board if needed.

The Pool BLOCK Schedule is as follows.

The 30 minutes between blocks will allow guards to clean.
