- _____ Cleaning front doors/windows – free walkways and parking lot of trash
- _____ Cleaning restrooms/breakroom/emptying trash
- _____ Sweeping and organizing backroom
- _____ Sorting and shelving merchandise (with manager’s approval)
- _____ Fixing and organizing indoor/outdoor merchandise/displays Opening DVD/CD cases to make sure there discs inside them.
- _____ Making signs (ask manager for materials and wording)
- _____ Door Greeter/Security – usually on a busy day with heavy customer traffic
- _____ Customer Service – walking around the store asking customer for any assistance.
- _____ Assisting cashiers with bagging when busy.
- _____ Assisting with donation drop offs/pickups
