

Pool Rules

LIFEGUARD ON DUTY



Entering the pool area outside of scheduled pool hours is prohibited.

- Lifeguards may use a swim test to assess swimming ability of patrons.
- No running, horseplay, spitting or throwing of objects in pool area.
- No diving, flips or somersaults from the deck.
- No food, gum or glass bottles allowed on pool deck.
- Eat at picnic table area only.
- No toys, lifejackets or flotation devices are allowed in the pool, unless part of a Rochester Recreation & Arena swim class.
- Lifeguards/staff only in designated areas. This includes lesson times.
- A shower must be taken before entering the pool.
- Prohibited items include alcohol, drugs, tobacco products and all vaping/electronic smoking paraphernalia.
- Anyone under the influence of drugs/alcohol is prohibited.
- · Weapons of any kind are prohibited from the pool area.
- Shoulder-length hair or longer must be tied back.
- Lifeguard may remove anyone who appears to have an open cut, sore or rash or any signs of contagious disease. A doctor's note may be required to reenter the pool.
- No pets allowed. Service animals are welcome.
- All children under 3 years old and any patron who is not potty trained must wear a swim diaper when using the pool.
- Children under 42" tall must be within arm's reach of a responsible adult/guardian while in the water. Each supervising adult may have no more than 3 children under 42" with them at a time.
- Children 11 years old and under must be accompanied by a responsible adult/guardian in the pool area at all times.

Rochester Recreation & Arena staff reserve the right to dismiss or deny any patron use of the pool that refuses to follow the rules or compromises safety.
