

Sairam Sai Devotees,

During the time of Caronavirus pandemic the temple needs to follow strict guidelines to ensure safety, security and cleanliness, and prevent spread of the virus. We request you to follow the following guidelines while visiting the temple to have a peaceful darsan of Baba and seek his blessings.

1. Please visit the temple with appointments. No devotee will be allowed without a prior appointment. Please make appointments using the link provided on temple website.
2. Please have a face mask all the time while in the temple. No one will be allowed inside without a proper mask.
3. When you enter the temple at your appointment time, please follow instructions of volunteers to verify your appointment.
4. After your appointment is located and verified in the system, the volunteers will direct you to the sanctum via the main entrance at the plaza area. Please stand in the line in marked spaces and maintain social distance.
5. If your appointment is not found, you will not be allowed darsan. You will be asked to leave the temple. Volunteers are not allowed give you appointments. However, you can go back to your car and sign up for any open appointment slots.
6. Volunteers will check the body temperature using a touchless thermometer. If it is over 101 degrees you will not be allowed darsan.
7. Devotees are not allowed into the first/ground-floor of the building. Kitchen, dining and restrooms are closed for public. If you require elevator access please let the volunteers know.
8. Please avoid touching any surfaces including hand railings, floor, steps, doors and door handles, etc.
9. Please move continually in the line, do not sit or kneel on the floor or stay in front of Baba.
10. Satagopam, theerth, prasad or udi will not provided to devotees.
11. Please do not bring any Prasad to the temple including fruits, flowers, milk or any material donations. You will not be allowed to take anything into the sanctum.
12. Please avoid contacting priests, employees or volunteers and do not give them any such material.
13. Cash donations can be made in the hundi or pay using a credit card at the counter or online.
14. Please leave the temple after darsan as quickly as possible to minimize the exposure. Please do not stay or socialize in the sanctum or in and around the building.
15. We suggest children under 12 years age and senior citizens over 65 to avoid visiting the temple if possible due to their higher chance of vulnerability to the virus.
16. These guidelines do not circumvent CDC guidelines. Please follow all CDC guidelines and in addition temple guidelines to ensure the safety of yourselves and other devotees in the temple.
