

**2020 MIBC PICNIC AREA & GROUNDS
MEMBER GUIDELINES**

PRIOR TO ARRIVAL ON SITE

Protect against infections:

- Stay at home if you are sick. Anyone who feels any symptom related to COVID-19, is not allowed on property.
- Members only. Groups of 5 or less or single household.
- A parent/guardian must accompany juniors under the age of 18 yrs.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided at pickleball/tennis courts and in the restroom.
- Bring tablecloths for the picnic area.
- Bring towels for the lawn chairs.
- Bring your own basketballs/volleyballs and pickleball equipment for single household play. No equipment provided or shared.
- Picnic table reservations are made using an on-line Signup Genius (www.mibeachclub.com/reservations-page).

WHILE ON SITE (Club hours: 8:00AM – 9:30PM Daily)

Members are encouraged to wear face masks to protect their fellow members while on property when social distancing is not possible.

PICNIC AREA:

- Arrive at the time of your table reservation to ensure a smooth transition.
- Your reservation is for a designated area within the picnic grounds. Within the area, at the time of your reservation, tables are first come, first serve.
- Do not share food or drinks.
- When BBQing, use the disinfectant spray and paper towels provided under the sink in the BBQ area to wipe down BBQ handles *before* and *after* use.
- Picnic tables are treated daily with disinfectant spray.
- Tablecloths are recommended.
- BBQs are cleaned daily.

GROUNDS:

- The bathroom adjacent to the Wave Café is open for member use and cleaned daily. Showering is highly discouraged.
- Lawn chairs and umbrellas are setup in observance of social distancing. Please refrain from moving furniture.
- Towels/blankets are recommended for the lounge chairs.
- Lawn chairs are treated daily with disinfectant spray.
- The playground toy is closed.

WHEN LEAVING THE CLUB

- Please vacate your table in the picnic area 10 minutes *before* the reservation ends to allow for a smooth, socially distanced transition.
- Wash your hands thoroughly or use a hand sanitizer when leaving the Club.

Note: Failure to adhere to “Picnic Area & Grounds Guidelines” may result in loss of club privileges.
