

As we gather again for the celebration of Mass, we are all asked to do our part to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Out of an abundance of caution for others gathered, please be aware that prior to entering the church an usher will ask you a series of screening questions.

Please be patient and wait for their instructions regarding seating, as we must comply with social distancing guidelines.



We ask that everyone takes the following precautions:

Stay home if you are ill, elderly, anxious, or immunocompromised. Bishop Knestout has dispensed all Catholics in the Diocese from their Sunday Mass obligation.



Maintain six feet of social distance from others who are not from your household at all times while in the church or on church property.



All those ages 3 and older must wear a face mask or face covering. Be sure the mask covers your nose and mouth.



Refrain from physical contact, such as holding hands during the Our Father and shaking hands at the Sign of Peace.



Sanitize hands when entering and leaving church. If possible, please bring a personal supply of hand sanitizer to use before receiving Communion.



You are strongly encouraged to receive Communion in the hand.

If you have a fever or symptoms of COVID-19 you will not be permitted to enter the building.
