FAQs AND GUIDELINES FOR IN-PERSON SUNDAY WORSHIP AT ROCKLAND

The below guidelines are essential for this weekend (6/7/2020). If you do not feel like you can comply, we understand, but please stay home until the guidelines can be loosened to where you are comfortable. Also, please exercise wisdom about whether or not to come, and we advise to err on the side of caution. We will be livestreaming both services and looking at your pictures on the chairs until we are all back together!

OK - on to the details!

DO WE HAVE TO SIGN UP IN ADVANCE?

You sure do! Everyone who plans to attend needs to be registered.

WHAT TIME DO WE NEED TO BE THERE?

Be there 10-15 minutes before the service.

DO I HAVE TO WEAR A MASK AND GET MY TEMPERATURE TAKEN?

According to the latest guidance form the governor's office for "houses of worship", masks are strongly recommended but <u>not</u> required. We will <u>not</u> be taking temperatures of anyone but our staff and volunteers.

WHAT ELSE WILL BE DIFFERENT?

You will be greeted by the staff with waving instead of shaking hands, you will need to check-in when you get here, and there won't be any handouts, plate passing, or fellowship time.

CAN WE HUG?

Not this week. Sorry, Ed. 🙂

WILL THERE BE COMMUNION?

We will have communion as an option. We will have volunteers wearing gloves and masks who have been temperature-checked that morning handing out individual, sealed communion packs at the beginning of the service.

WILL THERE BE A DOLLAR BILL PROGRAM?

Yes! The students were unable to go on their mission trip to Puerto Rico as planned, so bring your dollars and there will be an opportunity to drop them (along with your regular offering) in secure boxes as you enter or exit. If you can't make the service, no problem! We are going to have a drive-by dollar bill program as well this week!

IS THERE ANY PROGRAMMING (KIDS, STUDENTS, ETC.) BESIDES WORSHIP?

Nope. There are no Sunday Bible Studies, including nursery, kids, and students. Families will be worshipping together. During the kids blessing they can stand where they are.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

Bring a <u>Bible</u>! We have two stations with <u>hand sanitizer</u>, but if you could bring your own, that will help ours last longer. (Parents: you might bring something for your kids to do during the service.)

HAS THE CHURCH BEEN CLEANED?

Absolutely! The church has been thoroughly cleaned according to Colorado and JeffCo Health Dept directives. In addition, we have sanitized the church with anti-microbial misting. We also reached out to a company that specializes in ventilation, and got their advice to keep the doors open during the service. We have added time between the services to clean, will be sitting on alternating rows (so you won't sit where someone sat the service before you) and have a crew cleaning all the touchpoints (door-handles, etc.) before each service.

WHAT DOES THE FUTURE HOLD?

The only certain thing I know is that one day we will worship in the Church Triumphant. Other than that we are taking it a week at a time!
