



## Dixon Montessori Charter School Phantom Fireworks Booth: Work and Safety Protocols

These protocols are to ensure the safety and health of our volunteers within the booth as well as our customers:

- 1. Prior to their shift, volunteers will self-screen for any symptoms.
- 2. Volunteers within the booth will maintain a 6-foot distance from one another. The size of the booth will allow this.
- 3. Windows at the front of the booth as well as the doors on the side of the booth are to remain open at all times to keep outside air circulation within the booth
- 4. Face coverings are required for volunteers during their shifts. We encourage you to bring your own face covering. Disposable masks will be provided if needed.
- 5. Hand sanitizer for volunteers will be provided inside of the booth.
- 6. Disposable gloves will be provided for volunteers; however, wearing gloves is not required
- 7. Disinfectant spray will be provided to clean all payment portals and styluses between uses as well as high-contact areas
- 8. All high contact areas are required to be disinfected between volunteer shift changes
- 9. Floor markings outside of the booth will ensure customers are maintaining 6 feet of distance
- 10. Signs will be posted outside of the booth stating that customers are required to wear masks to approach the booth to buy fireworks.
- 11. Signs will be posted outside of the booth encouraging customers to use contactless payment options
