After-School Enrichment Program March 4 – March 26, 2020

Dear Parents:

Once again, the Delaware Township School Partners in Education (DTS PiE), along with the Delaware Township Board of Education, is offering after-school enrichment classes this winter. **The program will run on Wednesday and Thursday for four weeks beginning on March 4**th **and March 5**th, **respectively, and run until March 25**th **and 26**th. *There are some courses that have schedule exceptions so please note these as you register*. Two snow dates are already planned for April 1, 2, 8 and 9th.

The Enrichment program costs about \$6,000 to run, is open to all students at DTS, and serves about 200 students a year. We suggest a payment of **\$50 per child**; if they do more than one class, please consider paying a little more to offset costs. If you have already paid the annual Program Fee for 2019-2020, no payment is necessary but additional contributions are appreciated. We welcome all children regardless of ability to pay. If your child(ren) want(s) to participate and you are not in a position to pay, please register anyway.

New this year, we are utilizing Signup Genius for registration; the link is - https://www.signupgenius.com/go/10C084EAFA92AA3F85-dtspie and will be posted on PiE's website (www.dtspie.com). Registration will go live at 10 a.m. on February 12, 2020 and remain open until February 23rd, 2020. If you do not have access to the internet to register your child, please contact Julie Luster-Roell at 908-237-8181 or via email at julieautumn24@gmail.com. Please backpack any payments to DTS PiE's attention no later than February 24, 2020. Since registration is online, there will be no communication confirming the class your child is enrolled in so please make sure you note this when you register.

Children are expected to follow the behavior standards required during the regular school day. Classes begin immediately after school and ends at 4:15 p.m. Dismissal will be at the middle school exit. Per school rules, any child in 4th grade and younger must be signed out by a parent or guardian. Additionally, please make sure to send a note <u>daily</u> indicating your child will be staying after school for <u>each day and each week</u> of Enrichment – students without a note will be dismissed per their typical arrangements.

This program is run by volunteers and cannot continue without your help. Parent volunteers are needed to assist the instructors and help with logistics. If your child/children will be participating in a program, please consider volunteering if only for one day; volunteering can be done online too. The attached form includes a description of each course and a payment form. Please note that all classes are limited in size and to specific age groups.
