Role description:	The 2020 Festival of Trees will operate as a guided tour at Elm Bank Garden. The role of the tour guide is to lead a group of up to 22 guests through a series of 4 large rooms and an outside fire pit location on a strictly timed schedule . This is a critical role ensuring a positive guest experience, the smooth operation of the event and total separation of guest groups through accurate time keeping. Full training and support will be given for this role.
Main tasks:	Attend training (zoom and /or in person) to learn route, content and safety protocols Greet and converse with groups of up to 22 guests as a key part of their Festival of Trees experience Guide your designated group to rotate through rooms on a strict timed schedule as directed by central walkie-talkie system Remain with your designated group at all times Enforce timing, keep group together and monitor covid safety protocol observance for your designated group
Required skills, qualities and experience	Confidence in following and enforcing event rules for health and safety Cheerful and friendly disposition, comfortable interacting with guests and family groups of all ages, creating a special holiday experience for all. Complete reliability and dependability in fulfilling shifts as scheduled Willingness to undertake tasks exactly as requested to ensure tightly coordinated rotations of guest groups Comfortable interacting with 2 groups of 22 guests per shift, all following strict masking and social distancing protocols at all times.
Training and support	The tour guide role is critical to the delivery of the 2020 Festival of Trees



available:	as it ensures that we are able to keep guests entirely separated into groups, guaranteeing no large gatherings of guests and 100% traceability of attendee contacts.
	Tour guides will be supplied with full written protocols for each aspect of the role; a zoom meeting (various times available) and a route walk through prior to their first shift.
	Tour guides will also be invited to participate in a weekly team review for refresher training and additional support.
	At all times during Festival of Trees there will be a named supervisor available to address any concerns arising, and respond as needed. Tour guides will have walkie-talkie connection to staff throughout.
