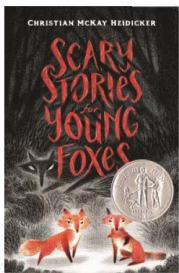

Registration is required each month. Once registration is completed, our host will email the link in advance to the monthly event.

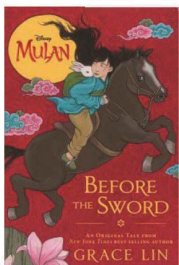

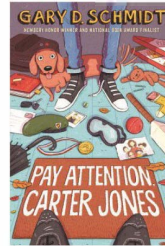
Scary Stories for Young Foxes

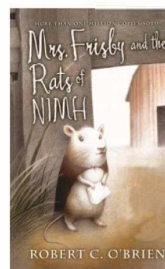
The Magic Misfits
