## Elite Junior Challenge Ladder Rules and Procedures

1. We require a minimum tennis ability when looking to participate in the Junior Challenge Ladder. Participants must know how to keep score, be able to get serves in on a somewhat consistent basis, and be able to sustain a rally.

## 2. Match Timing

Matches will be either 60 or 90 minutes in length. Matches will be played between the hours of 11:00am -5:00pm on Sundays.

- Green Ball matches will be 60 minute long, unless agreed upon in advance to do 90 minutes.
- Regular Ball matches are 90 minutes long.

Match times will only differ if North Shore has an event such as a CTC program, tournaments, college matches, etc. In those situations there may be a slight variance.

When you register, please let us know if you have any timing conflicts, we will do our best to fit your schedule, although we cannot guarantee all requests.

- 3. You may request two matches per day. We will do our best to honor those requests when openings are available.
- 4. <u>Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your scheduled match time.</u>
- 5. Matches will be administered using USTA rules and regulations.
- 6. Each match starts with a 5 minute warm-up.

## 7. Scoring:

- a. Please use scorecards and rotate on odd games
- b. Matches will consist of regular scoring play set, total games determines the winner. A tie goes to the higher player on the ladder.
- c. Lateness: 1 game per every 5 minutes.
- d. Report scores and return balls to Marty upon completion of the match. Scores will be entered by Tuesday for the ladder to be updated.

- 8. There are both singles and doubles matches for the challenge ladder. Singles are offered every week and doubles will be offered the last Sunday of the month (when COVID-19 regulations change).
- 9. Sportsmanship will be strictly enforced according to the USTA Code of Conduct. Because we are publishing results there is no coaching allowed from parents during play.
- 10. On court issues: Players have been taught to raise their racquet if there is an issue on their court.
- 11. The InterTennis software system will be used. The website is <u>www.intertennis.com</u>. We will utilize the leap frog system - the winner of the match takes over the higher number on the ladder. Numbers will change weekly. Numbers may also change as players are added/dropped from the ladder. An updated ladder will be posted in the North Shore lobby weekly.
- 12. Registration for Challenge Ladder:
  - a. Player commitment is on a weekly basis no sessions. All registration will be done via Sign Up Genius.
  - b. The registration link is <u>eliteclubs.com/challengeladder</u>
  - c. Parents/players must register via Sign-Up Genius and must update play information weekly by Tuesday at 10pm for the following Sunday.
  - d. The challenge ladder is open to Elite members only.
- 13. Parents will be notified by Friday night for the upcoming weeks' playing time via email from Marty.
- 14. Players and parents will not be given opponent's names ahead of time. We want players to get used to playing weaker, even, and better players. There are a lot of changes during the week which makes it impossible to give out opponent's names.
- 15. Players must play at least one time per month in order to keep their spot on the challenge ladder. Player might be moved down the ladder or taken off.
- 16. New participants will be placed on the ladder at the discretion of the coordinator.
- 17. <u>Cost</u>:
  - a. Singles: \$16/person for 60 minute matches and \$20/person for 90 minute matches.
  - b. Doubles: \$12/person for 90 minute matches
  - c. Includes match play, balls and ladder organization.

- 18. <u>Defaults</u>: If one player does not show up for their match without having given 48-hour notification by 11am on Friday, they will be charged for their match and the match will be a default. Please do not just not show up.
- 19. <u>Viewing</u>: Please do not sit on your son/daughter's court during match play. Courts 2-7 must be viewed on the lobby. Courts 8-11 can be viewed from either court 8 or court 11.
- 20. <u>From a coaching (learning) standpoint:</u> Match results and specific details will be shared with Elite pros. We see this ladder and Sunday match play as a learning tool, so it will be treated that way. The ultimate purpose of this ladder is to facilitate the improvement of your child.
- 21. Rules and procedures can be amended at anytime. Please check back periodically. If any major changes happen we will let you know via email.
