The Festival will be held outside on the grass in the front of the church, facing West Road.

- There will be shade for all participants.
- There not be access to electricity.
- Please bring chairs for everyone at your booth.

Your booth may include: décor, food, handouts about your country, native dress, maps and/or whatever else you feel will express the uniqueness of your country/region.

Food: All food must be prepared in a Covid-safe manner.

- Food must be individually pre-packaged. Tasting cups with lids or a zip-lock bag are suggested. The containers can be kept warm in a cooler or a warming tray with sterno.
- Open containers of food or drink are not permitted.
- As soon as you determine what kind of packaging you will use, please email Dan Stark so there are adequate supplies.

If you run out of food, please keep your table open. Please do not tear down before 5:00.

There will again be passports for children. The flag stickers should be laid out on your table so children can pick them up, rather than handed to them.

The following will be provided: tasting cups and lids, zip lock bags, plastic ware, napkins, white plastic table covering, and a flag for the country you are representing.
