Are you interested in being a room parent for your child's class?

Room parent duties are a little different than in the past since volunteers going into the classroom are limited at this time. As of now, the procedure will be similar to last year. A room parent will contact the teacher to see if she/he would like snacks, drinks, etc. to be brought in for the students on each holiday (Halloween, Christmas, Valentine's Day). If the teacher does, then the head room parent can make the arrangements or contact some of the other room parents from that classroom for help. All snacks and treats need to be prepackaged and store bought. No homemade treats are allowed at this time.

Some room parents may need to help a little more than others depending on the grade level and what is needed. For example, seventh grade room parents may need to help in some way at eighth grade graduation time.

Room parents will also be asked to help organize a basket for their grade level for the May 2022 festival's Bid-n-Buy booth. Since we are not collecting for both the October 2021 festival and May festival, the hope is that the baskets in May will be spectacular! Some of you who were room parents in the 2019-2020 school year may even have items or money still from the canceled May 2020 festival basket. This can be added in for the May festival basket or if you have something that you would like to donate at this time for the October Bid-n-Buy, please contact Sean McGrail 513-240-9565.

In case the situation changes and room parents are able to be in the classroom and with the students, all room parent volunteers must be Safe Parish registered and will be approved by the parish office.

If you are interested in volunteering to be a room parent, sign-ups will be a little different this year. Attached is a sign-up genius link. Each classroom will need one head room parent who will be in contact with the teacher to see what is needed. Each classroom can also have up to five additional room parents to assist the head room parent if additional help is needed. We are asking at this time that you only sign up for one position even if you have multiple children in the school. This will give others an opportunity to help also. If there are spots that do not get filled that are needed, we may then ask people to help in more than one classroom.
