We are looking forward to welcoming you to our in-person Family Worship Service at RCCG Cornerstone Chapel Calgary on Sunday.

With the lifting of all restrictions by the Province of Alberta, we have increased our in-person Sunday Service attendance to 30 people per service. As we come in for service, our priority is the health and safety of everyone, that is why we will continue to maintain some of the great Public Health and Alberta Health Services (AHS) recommendations that we had found to be valuable and effective during times of restrictions. We ask that you take the time to read and note the following.

1. Please if you or any member of your family is exhibiting any symptoms/signs of Covid-19 infection, please do not visit the church at this time. We ask that you stay at home, and call the Alberta Health line at 811 for follow up.
2. If in the past 14 days, you returned from travel outside of Canada, had close contact with someone confirmed as having COVID-19, or experiencing fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, painful swallowing, stuffy nose, headache, muscle or joint ache, fatigue, severe exhaustion, nausea, vomiting, loss of sense of smell or taste, conjunctivitis (pink eye), that you **DO NOT VISIT THE CHURCH AT THIS TIME**. However, if you qualify for "fully vaccinated traveler exemption," you can attend in-person services five days after you arrive in Canada, as long as you are not exhibiting any of the symptoms noted above.
3. Please try to arrive in church about 10 minutes before the Sunrise Service at 8:00 am or Sunset Service at 10:00 am. Upon arrival, use the touchless door sensor to the left of the doors to open the doors to enter the building.
4. Upon arrival, please walk up to the Mask Recognition and Body Temperature Measurement System to complete your mask compliance and temperature check. If confirmed that your temperature is okay and you have a mask on, please enter the church. If your temperature is higher than usual, we ask that you please return home, call 811, and monitor your health condition. You can feel free to let the Pastor know so that the church will follow up with you.
5. Chairs have been placed apart to ensure physical distancing measures. Therefore, we ask that you sit on a chair that has already been set and not add or move any other chair in the sanctuary.
6. We still have a mask mandate in RCCG Cornerstone Chapel, so please bring and wear your mask before entering the church building. Upon entry, please discard any disposable mask you came with into the garbage bin (take off and keep any reusable mask in your bag or pocket) and pick up a new mask from the table at the entrance. Wear this mask and keep them on at all times while inside the church building.
7. Infants and children are allowed into the church building for in-person services. However, since children's church is not yet open, children must sit with their parents.
8. Everyone attending the service is encouraged to observe proper hand hygiene upon entrance by sanitizing their hands with the hand sanitizer at the entrance and hand


sanitizers within the church when in the church. Hand sanitizing stations with sanitizers containing at least 60% alcohol content are provided at the entrance, exit, in the main sanctuary, and throughout the church building.

9. Doors inside the church will be left open to reduce the potential of touching door handles, while the entrance door will be closed and operable via a touchless device.
10. Shaking hands and hugging is okay only if individuals involved are okay with this.
11. You should follow proper respiratory etiquette practices at all times. These practices include coughing and sneezing into the elbow or a tissue, discarding tissues into a lined garbage bin, and washing hands afterward.

We trust that you will follow these guidelines to ensure that we all enjoy our worship together.

I look forward to seeing and having a great time of worship with you in the church on Sunday.
