



VISITATION GUIDELINES

- All visits must be scheduled in advance.
- Masks must be worn by visitors at all times. Masks are available if needed.
- All visitors must complete the COVID-19 questionnaire and be temperature screened upon arrival. Visitors will be denied entrance if they report or are observed with signs/symptoms of COVID-19 infection, have had recent exposure to a COVID-19 positive person, or have a temperature of 100.0 degrees or greater.
- No more than two visitors per resident are allowed per scheduled visit.
- Visitors must remain in designated areas and maintain social distancing. Visitors should maintain at least 6 feet of distance from all other visitors, residents, and staff for the entire duration of the visit.
- Visits are limited to 60 minutes.
- Please perform hand hygiene before your visit using the alcohol-based hand sanitizer located at the entrance and throughout the facility.
- Physical contact with the resident you are visiting is strongly discouraged. However, if you and the resident are fully vaccinated, the resident may choose to have close contact (including touch) with you while wearing a well-fitted face mask and performing hand-hygiene before and after.
- Before you leave the visitation area please perform hand hygiene using the alcohol-based hand sanitizer located throughout the facility.

Visitation is contingent on compliance with these guidelines.
