



Are you ready to have some fun this summer - The Rock County Cancer Coalition Team is excited that you are volunteering at the ABC Supply Stadium, during a Sky Carp game. Once the volunteer slots are filled for each game, we may open up more availability in different concessions in the stadium. Thank You for supporting those fighting cancer in Rock County!

What this will look like - You will show up wearing khaki pants/shorts – not cargo, closed-toe shoes - we recommend non-slip, and hat - either Sky Carp, Marlins, solid color without a logo or RCCC will provide a hat. Two hours before the start of the game. Upon check-in, you will be given a uniform shirt and a name badge. Your supervisor will take you to your location for the evening and lead you through how to open your location. At some point during your shift, you will be given a 30-minute break where you can have a complimentary meal from one of our concession stands. Once the game ends, your supervisor will lead you through how to close your location.

What you will be doing - Concessions operate in teams of two. The Cashier/Drinks person is responsible for taking the fan's order, punching it in, taking payment and getting any soft drinks, beer or bottled beverages. They also call out the food ordered to their partner. This role is only for those volunteers that are 18 years or older as they are handling alcohol and cash. The Food person is in charge of listening for their partners' food order and fulfilling them. Some examples would be assembling a hot dog basket, grabbing a bag of peanuts or popcorn etc. Super easy. For this role, volunteers can be 16 years of age or older.

Where can we park while we are volunteering at an event?

When you arrive, you will enter through the loading dock off Shirland Ave. Parking in the Centerfield lot is reserved for our guests, so you will need to park either at the Bus Stop or find public parking in town. We recommend carpooling and having volunteers dropped off near check in.
