
HOW WE DO IT

There is no one device or solution to effectively prevent all types of accidental childhood injuries. Instead, Safe Kids combines multiple strategies to reduce injuries.

IT'S WORKING

We are proud of the facts that since the inception of U.S Safe Kids in 1987, there has been a 45% decrease in the number of childhood deaths caused by accidental injury. That decrease relates to over 34,000 lives saved. At the same time, the number of Safe Kids coalitions in the United States has risen to 316.
