Communion Setup and Serve

Service and/or Standing Continuous Communion

- 4 Communion Servers at 2 stations, (Pastor is 1 of the 4).
- Station 1: Pastor, 1 person with wine and grape juice (West side of church)
- Station 2: 1 person serving bread, 1 person wine and grape juice (East side of church)
 - *Pastor likes to switch sides serving bread so that she has a chance to commune everyone over the weeks. Please follow her lead to determine which side you will serve.*
- Gluten Free: Pastor or person serving bread will offer rice crackers and wine/grape juice is gluten free

10 am service (see pictures right/below)

- 2 full trays (inner circle has 8) of wine with grape juice in the middle, 1 half full trays of wine with grape juice in the middle
- 1 pottery chalice: empty
- 1 pottery pitcher: fill with 1-2 inches of wine
- Pottery plate: 4-5 whole pieces of bread
- 1 amber colored heart: rice crackers from small Plastic container.

Some notes on communion:

- Arrive around 15-20 minutes early to setup
- Communion trays hold from 40 to 55 cups per tray (6 cups in the center is around 40, **8 cups in the center is around 55**)
- Be sure baskets are out, if basket holders aren't available basket can sit on heat covers or a small stool
