## **INDECENT: Self Tape Guidelines**

Greetings Actors! While attending in-person auditions for INDECENT on **Sunday, October 9th** is preferred, self-tapes are also acceptable if you are unavailable. Please see the guidelines for submitting a self tape below.

- 1. Please choose the role(s) you would like to audition for and locate the appropriate side made available by JTGR.
- 2. Rehearse and make some bold choices. While memorization is not required the more familiar you are with the side the better your audition will be.
- 3. Acquire a reader if you're auditioning with a scene. This person will be directly next to the camera reading the other characters lines. If you are performing a monologue, place your eye-line just off camera as well.
- 4. Find a camera. A smart-phone camera or computer camera is perfectly adequate. Frame yourself in a medium close up from your chest to just over the top of your head.
- 5. Make sure the space you are filming in is well lit and quiet so we can see and hear you.
- 6. Please "slate" or state your name at the beginning of the audition.
- 7. Please upload your audition to an **UNLISTED link** on Youtube and email it to <u>caitlinhartcasting@gmail.com</u> by end of day on Sunday, October 9th.
- 8. You can see an example of one of my favorite theatre self tapes <u>HERE</u>. I cast Linn off of this tape without any in-person auditions.
