

INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTCARDS FOR ILLINOIS SUPREME COURT

*Thank you for writing postcards with Indivisible Evanston. Your efforts will help ensure that voters know the importance of the **Illinois Supreme Court election**. We are writing voters in the 3rd Judicial District which has a critical race in November. Each pack has 96-98 addresses and 100 cards in case you need extra cards.*

1. SEE SCRIPT ON OPPOSITE SIDE. Please follow the script exactly.

2. Sign the message with only your first name. Do **not** include your full name or return address.

3. Once you have completed the sheet, you should shred or recycle it.

4. Proofread all cards to check for stamp, completeness, and that the first name on the message and the address are the same.

5. **Postcard stamps are now \$.40, but the price goes up to \$. 44 beginning July 10th. All postcard stamps are considered “forever” stamps. These stamps will be valid for use on postcards, even when the rate goes up.**

6. All cards need to be mailed by September 26th.

Studies have proven that receipt of postcards close to election day is most effective. These are being mailed in time for absentee voters to receive them. You can either:

a. Hold onto the completed cards and mail them yourself by **September 26th**; or

b. No later than **September 24th**, bring the completed cards back to Candace’s home (2744 Eastwood Ave.) or Leslye’s home (1216 Madison St.) for us to mail. **Please do not return cards without postage.**

7. Tips for writing postcards:

a. Don’t write too closely to the bottom of the card. The post office puts a sticker along the bottom with address info. (See Sample).

b. Leave room at the top right corner for the stamp.

c. You can use white-out to correct small errors, but don’t white out a large swath of writing. Use a new postcard if the error is major.
