

Best Practices for Voter Registration

What to bring:

- 1. You must bring your I.D in order to enter the USCIS building
- 2. Always bring a smile!
- 3. DO NOT bring any liquids
- 4. DO NOT bring any weapons of disposal

What to wear:

- 1. Comfortable Shoes
- 2. Dress respectfully modestly
- 3. **DO NOT wear any clothing or symbols that can be seem political** or towards one party because all of these organizations are non-partisan

Tips When Checking Voter Registration Forms:

- 1. Last name box must include the very last name of the individual
- 2. First name box must include the very first name of the individual
- 3. In the address box, they are asking for the **county not country**, and they must write their zip code
- 4. They can provide either the driverøs license or the last four digits of their social security number, but we highly encourage both.
- 5. They need to enter only the **last 4 digits** of their social security number
- 6. The birthday has to be input in the following manner: **MMDDYYYY**. Make sure they do not switch the month and day of birth.
- 7. They must check **yes** on the boxes that ask whether they are a citizen and are older than 17 ¹/₂ years old
- 8. They must write the date and sign the form. Make sure they write that todayøs date on the form.
- 9. They must sign their naturalization certificates and make sure their whole name is on the certificate and is correct.
- 10. They must use one ink pen when filling out the form
- 11. They must crossover every mistake they make and put their initials next to them
