The First Presbyterian Church of Dutch Neck Lemonade Under The Trees Host Duties

Thank you for hosting our summer lemonade under the trees. Summertime is a lighter attendance, so base your snacks on 50-75 people. If the weather is too hot or raining, the snack table can be set up in Fellowship Hall where there is air conditioning.

Here are some suggestions for snacks:

Mini Doughnuts (2-3 packages cut in half)
Entenmann's or other brand coffee cakes
Any brand cookies, crackers or brownies
Fruit (grapes, seedless watermelon, berries...etc.)
Pretzels or popcorn
Juices (2 large gallon size – any flavor – punch... etc.)

- 1. Make the lemonade, which is found in the coffee hour cabinet along the back wall by the windows. Use the large five-gallon cooler jugs. Usually three gallons is more than enough. Use the scooper in the mix, 8 scoops for every gallon. Stir in ice from the freezer using one of the large spoons in the utensil drawers.
- 2. Put out a pitcher or two of ice water.
- 3. Paper cups and napkins are found in the coffee hour cabinet.
- 4. Put the snacks in napkin-lined baskets that are found over the double sink to the right as you enter the kitchen.
- 5. Use a tablecloth on the table for snacks. They are stored in the cabinets near the back door or can be found hanging in the hallway. (Soiled tablecloths should be taken home and laundered.)
- 6. Put out the donation basket. Donations should be left in an envelope in the office, marked "Fellowship hour donations".
- 7. Set up approximately a dozen chairs for members needing to sit.
- 8. Save any leftover juice in the refrigerator and mark them "Fellowship."
- 9. Clean out the lemonade jug and leave to drain upside down by the sink. Put away paper supplies.
- 10. If there are a lot of snacks left over, please either take them with you or date them and place them in the freezer for the next week and let the host know they are there.
- 11. Please put recycling out and take the garbage out.
