

Donora Build Day Volunteer Packet

Including FAQ's & parking information. Please remember to sign and bring a waiver with you.

Thank you so much for getting your group involved and volunteering to help build affordable housing in Northern Virginia! Habitat for Humanity of Northern Virginia (Habitat NOVA) works to brings people together to build homes, communities and hope.

What time do I arrive? 8:30 AM

What is the expected finish time for the work day? 3:00 PM

Where is the build site? 6848 Donora Drive, Alexandria, Virginia 22306

Where can I park? Please parallel park along Groverton Street, Memorial Street or Clayborne Avenue. Please be courteous and don't crowd neighbor's driveways, and pay attention to restricted areas for fire hydrants.

What should I wear? Please wear comfortable, durable clothing: loose fitting jeans or work pants, short or long sleeve shirts, thick soled closed toed shoes or work boots. Most volunteers find it helpful to wear layers as the temperature can vary through the day. For your safety DO NOT wear shorts, tight fitting jeans, leggings, tights, sleeveless shirts or inappropriate footwear.

What should I bring? Feel free to bring a bagged lunch and a water bottle to help keep you hydrated! We'll have all the tools and materials you'll need.

What is the minimum age to volunteer? All volunteers must be 16 years or older to volunteer on a construction site. They must also have their parent or guardian sign their waiver form before volunteer.
