Due to COVID-19 Phase 2 Restrictions implemented by Governor Cooper on May 22, 2020, the following Foxfire Village Pool Rules for the 2020 Season will be enforced:

- If you have a fever, shortness of breath, cough, nasal congestions, runny nose, sore throat, nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea or have been in contact with anyone with these symptoms, you will **not be permitted** in the pool facility.
- Pool visitors are asked to wear face coverings when entering and exiting the pool facility and when not in the pool.
- Pool visitors are asked to practice social distancing (staying at least 6 feet away from others) and to wash hands frequently and/or to use hand sanitizer.
- The Emergency Maximum Capacity in the pool facility is thirty (30) pool patrons.
- The Emergency Maximum Capacity inside the swimming pool is fifteen (15) swimmers.
- All children <u>under 16</u> must be accompanied by an adult/parent. Children may not be "dropped off" at the pool, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- NO DIVING ALLOWED
- NO GUM CHEWING in the pool.
- NO HORSEPLAY, RUNNING, JUMPING, or doing FLIPS OFF THE SIDE OF THE POOL.
- No glass or metal containers/objects allowed in the pool, deck, or bathrooms.
- Smoking is PROHIBITED inside the pool facility and bathrooms.
- Pool toys, floats, noodles, and shared exercise equipment are PROHIBITED inside the pool facility.
- The bathroom showers are <u>out of service</u> and <u>may not be used</u>. Pool visitors can use the outside pool deck shower to rinse off before swimming in compliance with State Health Codes.
- Food of any type is PROHIBITED inside the pool facility.
- Alcoholic beverages are PROHIBITED.
- NO PETS ALLOWED except Service Dogs.
- Pool visitors must bring their own chairs and chaise lounges. Umbrellas will be provided but must stay in their designated areas.
- Plastic Bottle and Aluminum Can drinks are **PERMITTED** however all empty containers must be taken when leaving the facility.
- No Band-Aids or open wounds in the pool. Long hair must be pulled back in a hair tie. Bathing caps are not required.
- Diapers should not be worn in the pool. DO NOT put disposable diapers in trash can!
- Rubber pants or swimming pants with elastic leg area are REQUIRED.
- **DO NOT FLUSH** sanitary products in toilets. **As a courtesy to others**, USE receptacles provided in each bathroom stall.
- Please report any accidents, damage to pool or equipment and possible contamination immediately to the Pool Attendant.
