



TIPS

We have been using the reservation system for awhile now and wanted to offer some tips for ease of use.

- You will be required to create an account on SignUp Genius (SUG). Please review your settings & set them to receive Reminders. Remember to always use the same email address that you registered with, otherwise you won't be able to access SUG. And MOST IMPORTANT: each person must have their own, UNIQUE, email address to be accepted into the system.
- BE SURE to confirm that your computer is on your own account! If you share a computer, SignUp Genius will retain the previously signed in account unless you "logoff" or close down the machine.



- Remember, players must be a current Member of Camano Pickleball Club to use the courts during our reserved time slots. Sorry, guests are not allowed at this time.
- You can add the reservation to your calendar. SUG will offer a link in the Confirmation email and also at the screen Confirmation display. You can also use the link on the confirmation email to delete a reservation. Please take the time to delete reservations if you are not coming.
- Want to have access to SUG on your phone? Download the app. While not as convenient to use as a desktop, it will summarize on the opening page your reservations for the week.
- You can reserve more than one day/time each time you sign in; up to 5 per week and 1 per day. Be sure to go to the bottom of the page and click Submit and Sign Up to confirm your choices

- If you want to play in your own group, add other names to the "List Other Players" box, BUT...they must reserve their own slot for themselves. Entering their names in the "List Other Players" box DOES NOT reserve for them or remove a slot from that day/time
 - Also, entering an "alternate name" under your account does not reserve for someone else.
- Once you have a court reserved for a time slot you can ask your other players if they want to switch and rotate in players from other courts. Please be respectful if they wish to stay together as a team for COVID19 reasons.
- If you made a reservation and your court does not have 4 players, come anyway and see if another court will let you rotate into their matches. Or play with just two or 3 total players. It can be fun!
- In situations where not all courts are filled, players on non-filled courts should stand or sit by a court where they become the 5th player. The other players on that court need to sit-out a game to give all players equal playing time.
 - Example: Three filled courts and three extra players; each of the three extra players should select one of the other courts where they would like to be the 5th player. If you can't make a court reservation, PLEASE take the time to cancel (your name/slot will display an "X" to cancel) on SUG so others can take your place



- SIGNUP do not SHOWUP: If you see an open slot available always make a reservation, don't drive to the courts and assume you be able to play.
 - Signing Up will help Camano Pickleball Club adhere to the Island County requirements of opening our courts for play.

SignUp Genius Tips: July 2020 v2.0

- Once you have a reservation you can arrive up to 30 minutes early most days for the first time slot of the day to see if the court is open, to extend your playing time. If your reservation is at 11:30am you can come at 11, get set up and play longer. You cannot extend past your allocated time of 1pm if someone is waiting for the court. We do not want people waiting at all for social distancing reasons.
- If your reservation is for the second time slot of the day such as 1 pm to 2:30pm, you can extend your playing time on the court as long as no one else wants to use the courts. Please respect the needs of others wanting to use the Island County Public courts when the time exceeds our printed Camano Pickleball hours.
