## The Dubois Chamber of Commerce has received an exception approval from the county and state to hold our 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade this year!!

### Approval is based on our community implementing the following social distancing guidelines:

- 1. The parade route will be extended an additional mile to enable family groups to sit outside their homes, rather than congregate in crowds in the downtown area. The Parade will start at the Town Park and go down Ramshorn Street (as is usual). Floats will turn left on First St.-Right on Lincoln St. to Hough St. Ending at Ramshorn and First St. *The parade route will be 2 miles long rather then 1 mile*.
- 2. Floats will be announced on social media/internet in a live stream. This will enable those that are vulnerable and at risk to enjoy the parade without leaving their homes.
- 3. Parade volunteers will be provided with facemasks and hand sanitizers.
- 4. Floats are encouraged NOT to distribute candy or handouts to reduce the risk of COVID-19 exposure.
- 5. Businesses along main street are encouraged to assist in managing crowd control by ensuring social distancing in front of their businesses.
- 6. Parade observers and family groups are recommended to stay six feet apart.
- 7. Float participants are encouraged to implement social distancing guidelines on their floats.
