

NORTHPARK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION TENNIS / PICKLEBALL COURT COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES/RESTRICTIONS

Welcome back, neighbors! We are excited to open the tennis and pickleball courts. Please follow all guidelines below to keep the courts open.

This is an honor system. The HOA is not monitoring the courts and takes no responsibility for the conduct of participants.

- If you are feeling sick or have any symptoms, please stay home!
- Play at your own risk.
- Players must sign up using Signup Genius and agree to the waiver to use the courts.

 - The registration system limits your play to one hour. If there is no one registered when your hour is over, feel free to use the court until someone shows up for a registered time.
- Maximum of two tennis courts (no middle court) and two pickleball courts (one on each side of the fence) in use at a time.
- Maximum of 16 people on the courts at all times. No more than 4 people per court
- Only active players are allowed in the court area.
- Players must live in NorthPark or be family members.
- Players must always maintain the appropriate 6 ft. distancing in and around courts.
- Players must bring their own sanitizer, spray and/or wipes to clean the court area after each use.
 - Sanitize all the areas of the court that you used.
 - Sanitize the gate key area and the area on the gate where players touch to get in and out.
 - If this is not done, the courts will have to be closed again.
- Each player must have his/her own balls, labeled with his/her name.
- Players are asked to use either a foot or a racquet when returning a ball back to another player.
- Masks must be worn when not playing (e.g., when entering or exiting the courts).
 - All players are encouraged to wear a face mask (including while playing) while on the courts.
- All personal items must be stored behind the player on his/her side of the court.
- Players cannot switch sides.
- Players should congratulate the other player with a racquet bump.
- Please leave the court immediately after play. Do not congregate, linger, or socialize.
