Fever greater than 100.0 F
New or worsening cough (not associated with an existing /known condition –
smoking, snoring, allergy nasal drip
New or worsening shortness of breath or difficulty breathing (not associated with
existing/know condition or anxiety)
Fatigue
Myalgia (muscle/body aches of unknown cause)
Chills and/or chills with repeated shaking
New, worsening, or unexplained headache
New loss of taste or smell
Sore throat (not associated with an existing/known condition - smoking snoring,
allergy nasal drip)
New, worsening, or unexplained congestion or runny nose
New, worsening, or unexplained nausea or vomiting
New, worsening, or unexplained diarrhea
