## **COVID-19 / Guidelines**

## Updated on May 21, 2021

## 100% occupancy is allowed

At all times, the safety of our clergy, parishioners and guests remains especially important to us. And so, we ask for your full cooperation with adhering to these COVID-19 precautions:

- All who have symptoms or may have been exposed to COVID-19 must stay home.
- All who have traveled internationally or to a highly impacted area within the United States of America within the last 7 days must self-quarantine at home.
- Although there are no occupancy restrictions, we ask everyone to make reservations using our online reservation system. Physicians recommend this for the sake of contact tracing.

- Wearing face masks is required. This is mandated by Baltimore City. Face masks must cover nose and mouth at all times.
- The downstairs hall is also open for attendance in order to avoid overcrowding.
- At the front door, we will take your temperature with a touchless thermometer. If your temperature is above 100.4°F, you will be asked to leave.
- We will maintain good hygiene by cleaning/disinfecting all frequently touched surfaces.
- Small prosphoras will be available for commemorations. Start date and new procedure will be announced soon.
- Commemoration lists may be submitted in person at the candlestand or online.
   Online requests must be submitted by 10:00 PM Saturday. Click here.
- Moderate social distancing is encouraged while in church and in the hall.
- Choir is limited to the same five singers. However, rehearsals for all will soon begin.
- The church will be open only for Divine Services. Coffee hours are still suspended.
- General Confession will be offered 30 minutes before the start of each Divine Liturgy.
- Panikhidas and molebens will be served upon request.
