Volunteer Job Assignment: Wheel of Fortune

Time: 10 am – 5 pm Location: Hole #11

Duties:

- Please check by 10 am and be ready at Hole 11 before the first golfers arrive. This could be as soon as 10:30.
- Please bring a chair with you to sit in at your hole! A chair will NOT be provided for you. Two volunteers will be at this Hole.
- You will have one cart assigned for this hole.
- Set up shelter, table, dip jar, forms and Wheel if needed.
- As golfers approach the tee box, greet with a smile. Explain the rules of the WHEEL OF FORTUNE
- One Starkey volunteer will be designated to track the income.
- Rules of Play:
 - Every player spins the Wheel! Doesn't matter if they bought the hole games and have a wristband or not. (If a player chooses not to, that is OK)
 - o If they don't like what they landed on, they can pay \$20 to get out of a bad fortune.
 - We take cash, checks made out to Starkey Foundation, or credit card using the dip jar.
 - One dip of their credit card in the dip jar is \$20.
 - o If they really like their fortune, we also take tips! Point out the tip jar. ☺
- Please take plenty of photos of golfers as they spin the Wheel, react to their Fortune, and/or complete their activity. Many of the items should be fun!
- Some of the very photogenic options may be:
 - o Sing or Dance for your team Or choose a teammate to do so.
 - o Tee off with a kids club
 - Swing blindfolded, and more!
- Please notify Volunteer Support Brenda McKenney @ 706-0217 or Eileen @ 253-7607 if you need a break for the restroom, etc. Restrooms are located in the Clubhouse, between holes #6 & #7, and between holes #13 & #14.
- Please do not leave your station unattended! Please make sure that there is at least one volunteer monitoring game play.
- When the last team has come through:
 - Reconcile money collection forms
 - o Take tent down and collapse table (if applicable),
 - Collect signage, and pack remaining supplies in container (if any) to be returned to the Clubhouse.
 - Please return these items to the front of the clubhouse.
 - Turn in money collected to Golfer registration along with reconciliation report to hand to Michelle. Do not leave until cash is counted out to her and you both agree on the total.
- Assist in truck loading at conclusion of event.
- When you finish your assignment, please check out with Volunteer Support, document the time you left, and drop off your name badge. Thank you!
- Other duties as assigned.
