- CHECK IN AT VOLUNTEER CHECK IN FIRST.
- Volunteer check in is at the parking lot of Bell Carpet, on the corner of Douglas and Osage. Look for volunteer check-in near the loading truck. Volunteer check-in is separate from participant check-in.

Duties:

5:30

- Ice Runners will report to Volunteer Support.
- Refrigerated truck will be parked in the parking lot of Bell Carpet and will have the remaining ice to fill coolers as needed.

6:00

- Your job is to monitor the ice level in coolers in the various locations
- Replace ice as needed from extra stored ice in the ice trailer using carts or dolly's.
- Volunteers may be calling Volunteer Support for more ice in addition to your monitoring.
- Be flexible and ready to jump in where needed. If ice levels are good, please be willing to help out where needed, such as offering breaks to other volunteers.
- Keep in contact with Volunteer Support, Sherry Boesen to find out about needs.
- Beer and wine is NOT available for volunteers and/or Starkey staff. Only participants with a wristband may be served alcohol.

9:00

- Store Lead will make last call at 9:00
- Go to different locations if not assigned and help bring supplies and leftover alcohol to the loading area.
- Make sure all alcohol is taken to the loading area
- Your volunteer assignment is not complete until the area is fully broken down and everything is loaded on to trucks.
- You will then collect your volunteer thank you gift.
