



If you're a First-Time Seller, you'll find everything you need to know —right here in this Guide—to help you turn your outgrown kid items into CA\$H.



First Things First: REGISTER

Save your spot by registering as a Consignor at the event(s) you prefer.



The Basics



You will earn up to 70% on your sold items! The base percentage is 60% and you can increase that to 70% by helping for at least 4 hours during the sale. Note: if you are a power seller with over 300 items or a Mega Consignor with over 800 items, please see the FAQ section at the end of this guide.

Once you have registered on our site as a consignor for the Fall 2021 sale, sign up for your drop off appointment. You must have a drop off appt to consign with us. The \$15 consignor fee will be paid up front when you sign up for your appointment. This is due to a very large number of people consistently registering, then not dropping off, which makes it very difficult for us to accurately plan the event. There will be a discounted Early Bird registration fee available for anyone who registers within the early bird time frame. Any late registrations after September 1 will incur a \$5 late registration fee.

You can start tagging for the next sale NOW! Our tagging system doesn't shut down so you can pace yourself and tag all year long! Tags stay current in our system for 2 years!

You can either pick up your unsold item after the sale or you can choose to donate them to our charity partner, Friends of Forgotten Children. It's as easy as the click of a button when you create your tags on our site! When you mark ALL of your items to reduce and donate you will save \$5 on your consignor fee! This will be reimbursed to you into your consignor check.

Payday is super easy and fast! We pay you via an e-check that is delivered to your email account no later than 2 weeks after the sale is over!

You prep, price, tag and drop off your items at the sale! You don't have to sit at a vendor table the entire time or worry about sketchy meetups with strangers. See more details on how to be a stellar consignor in the following pages!

STEP #2 Soft





Keep | Toss | Sell

It's okay to **KEEP** the items that you just aren't ready to part with yet. **TOSS** the items that are too well-loved (stains, missing pieces, or are not working).

SELL the items that meet these 4 C's:

CLEAN

The newer it looks, the better it sells. Check carefully for stains and holes in clothing. Clean all clothing and non-clothing items thoroughly. Smell your clothing when you are tagging as well as we will also pull items that smell badly.

CURRENT

We are currently hosting All Seasons Sales. You may bring in both Summer and Winter items. Just don't bring in any of your vintage baby clothes, shoppers love current styles that are in fashion.

COMPLETE

Be sure all parts & pieces are present before you tag items. Shoppers want to open their items when they get home and find everything in working order.

COMPLIANT

Important Safety Guidelines apply to car seats, cribs, infant equipment & toys. All of the Recalls & Safety Standards are listed at **jbfsale.com** for you to check each of your items before you sell.

As you are thinking about prices, consider creating sets or bundles. Put together a set of same-size onesies or same brand pants. Bundle 6 pair of socks together, or several superhero figures. Shoppers love it, and you only have to create one JBF tag!

STEP #3 SICE





Where to Create Your Tags

Now that your items are inspected and bundled, it's time to log in to your JBF Profile and enter your tag data.



TIP! Talk-to-Text

If you are entering tags on your mobile device, use talk-to-text to go even faster.





Print Your TagsPrint tags with **BLACK** ink on 8.5"x11" **WHITE** cardstock. Tags print 9 per page. Any items tagged on colored cardstock wil be declined.

Preparing Your Items & Attaching Tags

Now that your JBF tags are printed, cut them apart and sort them by gender, type and size to make this step go smoother.



Gather these supplies to make your prep faster:

- hangers
- clear self-sealing bags (zip-loc)
- zip-ties
 - · clear tape & painter's tape
- scissorssafety pins or tagging gun
- ribbon/string
- · clear (saran) wrap
- hole-punch

TOYS & GEAR

Two Essentials:

- Tag is attached securely (won't fall off) &
- All pieces secured together (won't separate; tape bags closed)

CLOTHING

Hanging & Tagging Clothing

Clothing must be on a hanger. You can bundle socks, infant mittens & hats, as well as accessories in clear selfsealing bags or attach items together with a safety pin. Attach IBF tag with safety pin or tagging gun.



Hanger Direction

Be sure the hanger hook opens to the left, like a question mark. Attach JBF tag to front of item.







Creating Outfits

It's okay to bundle items into sets. Secure pieces to hanger using safety pins and then zip-tie hangers tightly together so outfit remains together as a set.



Tagging Gun

If you use a tagging gun to attach JBF tags, only puncture the garment tag or an inside seam so that you do not damage the fabric. If you tag through the fabric you will damage the item as tagging gun needles leave holes that do not close up after being washed. We will pull items tagged through the fabric with a tagging gun.

STEP #4 Drefo





Accessories

Use clear bags to bundle sets of socks, hair accessories, infant mittens and hats. Display neatly so shopper can see well. Place JBF tag inside and tape bag closed. Individual accessory items can just be tagged and then you can hang them with our clips at drop off.



Hats

Simply attach JBF tag to hats using a safety pin or tagging gun. No need to use a bag.



Hanging Multiple Items on a Hanger

Multiple items—that are all the same size—can be hung on a single hanger. Use a safety pin to attach pants/skirts to hangers.

STEP #5 DOO CHENDS.



You did it!

Now that your items are tagged, you'll want to pack items **organized by type and size** so that your Drop Off process is easy and fast.

- Plan for at least 60-minutes to drop off your items. Longer if you have 250+ items to drop off. Drive to the Hampshire Dome. Park...and Check In at your appointment time.
- You will then place all of your non-clothing items where they belong on the sales floor, making sure to assemble anything that isn't already assembled. You'll hang all clothing in gender/size areas on the racks behind the alphabet letter in each size that corresponds with the first letter of your Consignor number.
- Be sure to have your large item claim tickets already printed with the JBF price tag attached to it, attached to your large items (anything too big for a blue IKEA bag)
- Books will be placed into bins by book type and shoes sorted into gender/size bins for inspection.



How much do I earn for my sold items?

You earn 60% on your sold items as a baseline. If you sign up to help for at least 4 credit hours during the sale you will earn 70%! Help for 8 actual hours and you will also have your consignor fee cut in half (that will be reimbursed into your check). You can sign up for Team Member Shifts using the link we will plaster everywhere once they are available.

As a consignor, do I get to shop early?

YES! Consignors each get to shop at 5pm on Thursday, Sept 16. Event better is you get a ticket to bring your bestie to shop too! Team Members who help at the sale get to shop even earier! You do not need to pay for presale tickets, we will give them to your at drop off! You also get to shop early with TWO friends at the Half Off Presale on Saturday Sept 18th too! Additionally, if you are a Team Member helping at the sale, you can shop on Sunday from 11:30am-12::30pm at the 75% off Donates sale where any items marked reduce AND donate will ring up at 75% off! Note: No children under 12 years old may shop prior to 3pm on Friday except infants worn in a carrier.

Do I have to use cardstock for my tags?

Yes, you must use white cardstock, of at least 67lbs. We had an excessive amount of items tags printed on colored cardstock at the May 2021 sale & they don't scan correctly, so we will heavily enforce pulling & declining items tagged with anything other than white cardstock, that includes white printer paper as it is too thin and tags rip off easily.

How do I get paid?

Within two weeks fo the sale ending we will send your check via email. This e-check will come from Deluxe Checks as a secured link. All the instructions you need will be included for you to easily see how to print and deposit it like any other check.

Are the inspectors really strict?

Yes, we have very high standards at JBF & train our consignor's who help during inspection to ensure items are up to our standards. When you are inspecting your items at home we recommend using lots of natural light or bright lamps as the lights we have in the venue to inspect with are bright and unforgiving. Ensure there are zero stains (even the little tiny one that you don't think anyone will care about), no rips, all the buttons are attached, there isn't excessive pilling of the fabric, everything smells good and that you didn't tag through the fabric with a tagging gun. Shoes must be in excellent to new condition, (magic erasers work wonders on dirty rubber), no scuffed toes, no dirty soles, make them shine!

Can I sell baby gear?

Baby gear is one of the hottest sellers you can bring in! Make sure everything is **clean**, wipe down the plastic and clean the fabric and straps. Check strollers for mildew under the cover and rust on the wheels, ensure the seats are clean and free of stains. Pack and plays must be clean and not have any holes in the mesh. Ensure any baby gear has not been recalled by searching for the item on the CPSC.gov website. We pull any recalled items from the sales floor. Car seats must be clean and have a printed manual and completed car seat waiver signed by you left with it at drop off. Any infant seat bases and booster seats must also have a waiver completed for each one. Waivers can be found on our website and will be linked in your consignor emails.

How does marking my items to reduce and donate make my check bigger?

Studies conducted at several JBF Sales across the country proved that Consignor sell through rates were greatly increased when consignors tagged their items to reduce and donate. The reasoning behind it is if you tag it to reduce and donate, you price it to sell and do not use emotion when pricing. Many shoppers won't even look at items that are full price on half price day and they are more likely to actually purchase them while still full price. Additionally, if you tag ALL of your items to reduce AND donate we will reimburse half of your consignor fee back to you in your check!

What is a Power Seller and a Mega Consignor?

- 1. If you are a Power Seller (dropping off more than 300 items), and you wish to pick up your unsold items, we ask you to sign up for the 1pm-6pm Power Seller sorting and breakdown shift. *If you are donating all your unsold items this is not a requirement.
- 2. If you are a MEGA Consignor with over 800 items. A consignor registration fee for every 800 items or any part of 800 items in your inventory is required. Any additional consignor fees will be deducted from your check as only one will be paid when you sign up for a drop off time. (1-800 items = 1 consignor fee, 801-1600 items= 2 consignor fees, etc..) Please contact us directly by emailing carinaesamsel@jbfsale.com to notify us of your mega consignor status. You must also have MINIMUM of 1person per 800 items or any part of 800 items at the required Power Seller Sorting/Breakdown Shift. (1-800 items = 1person, 801-1600 items= 2 people etc)
