Re: RV Dry Camping RV Camping Area Regulations

Welcome RV Campers, to this year's games. Your positive experience is very important to us.

The RV Campers parking area will be located on the west-end of Central Winds Park, which is located in close proximity to Lake Jessup, just west of the games athletic field **NOTE: There is No overnight parking in the high school parking lot.** In an effort to make parking and set-up easy and fun for each of you, please be mindful of the following rules:

- Check-into the park Friday afternoon of the games weekend between 1 pm – 4 pm EST. to allow for plenty of daylight to get set-up safely.
- **ALL RV'S MUST BE SET-UP FOR: "dry camping" meaning no service at all.** ONLY Class A, Class B, Class Super B, or Class C may be parked in this special area. Units must have fresh water holding tanks, gray/black holding tanks, and a generator. City Ordinance forbids Campfires. **Therefore they are prohibited. "NO FIRES"**
- **GENERATORS:** may be used in the area from **6 A.M. to 11 P.M. only**. City Ordinance forbids generator use during quiet hours.
- **A LEVELING SYSTEM:** can be mechanical or hydraulic, manual or automatic.
- NOTE Parking Area is a Grass Field: **Levelers should use pads for the safety of the unit and you.**

- **WARNING:** Lake Jessup is home to the **greatest population of Alligators in Central Florida. No swimming or wading, no moonlight strolls in the woods. No kidding.**
- **RV PARKING** is for Friday, Saturday and Sunday night. All RVs must be out of the Camping area no later than noon on the following Monday.
- **NO TENT Camping:** The only exception will be the area reserved for the Boy Scouts, who are Games' Volunteers.
- **AREA SECURITY:** There will be Parking Volunteers to assist you. They are authorized to contact Winter Springs Police and/or medical assistance as needed. And you are always encouraged to dial 911 if required.

Now you are all settled in. So, how do you get to the FUN of The Games?

SHUTTLE BUSES: - Transportation to and from the MAIN GATE will be by Shuttle Bus. "Bus Stop # 2" is located next to the RV Camping area. This bus route shall be for all parking lots in the park. These Busses will run from 7:30 A.M. until 9:30 P.M. Saturday and 8:30 A.M. until 5:30 P.M. Sunday. If you choose to use this **FREE SERVICE** Remember to tell the driver that you are going to the RV Camping Area Stop # 2.

LOWER GATE ACCESS: - this gate is located approximately 200 Yards from the RV Dry Camping Area to the East past the football and baseball fields look for a very large baseball glove and the gate will be on your left.

Note: **Private Golf Carts are not permitted inside the fenced in games area during open hours.**
