SAFETY PRACTICES

- Practice social distancing – maintain 6ft apart from non-family
- Avoid physical contact with others
- Wash/sanitize hands upon arrival and as needed. Avoid touching your face
- Masks are required

SELF-SCREENING

Have you:

1. Been exposed or been in contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with Covid-19?
2. Experienced any of the following symptoms in the last 24hrs: cough, shortness of breath, fever or chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell?
3. Travelled outside the continental USA within the last 2 weeks or have you been exposed to someone who has travelled outside continental USA?

If you answered yes to any of these questions, we request that you DO NOT come to the church in the interest of safety to others.

DISCLAIMER

While no one can guarantee a completely safe environment or social event during this unprecedented pandemic, we are working hard to keep our community safe and we are asking you to partner with us in that mission. We want you to know that your health and safety is of the utmost importance to us.
