CANCELLATIONS:	Cancellations made prior to Monday, 3 January, will be eligible for a refund.
ENTRIES CLOSE	Advance entries will close on December 31, 2021. Entries from all Virginia residents received prior to the closing date will be accepted to range capacity. Every effort will be made to accept all non-resident competitors who enter before the closing date.

COACHING	Verbal coaching on the firing line will not be permitted. Non-verbal coaching is allowed.
PARTICIPATION PINS	A Junior Olympic participation pin provided by USA Shooting will be given to each competitor

TIES All ties will be broken in accordance with the rulebook.

SCORING PROTESTS A scoring protest of \$1.00 per shot may be charged.

- **RESIDENCE** Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. State residents are eligible for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd, place USA Shooting State Champion medallions. Residency is defined as to where the competitor holds a current and valid driver's license. If the competitor does not have a driver's license, residency is then defined as to where the compete for invitations to the National Championship but are not eligible for state awards.
- **ENTRY** Only scores from a registered State Junior Olympic match will count for an invitation to the National Junior Olympic Championship. Shooters may not compete in more than one state JOSC. Juniors who shoot in their own home state JOSC will not be allowed to shoot for an invitation in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a State JOSC and those who cannot attend their own State JOSC will be allowed to enter as a non-resident in another state. Non-residents must declare their home state at entry and are not eligible for state resident awards.
